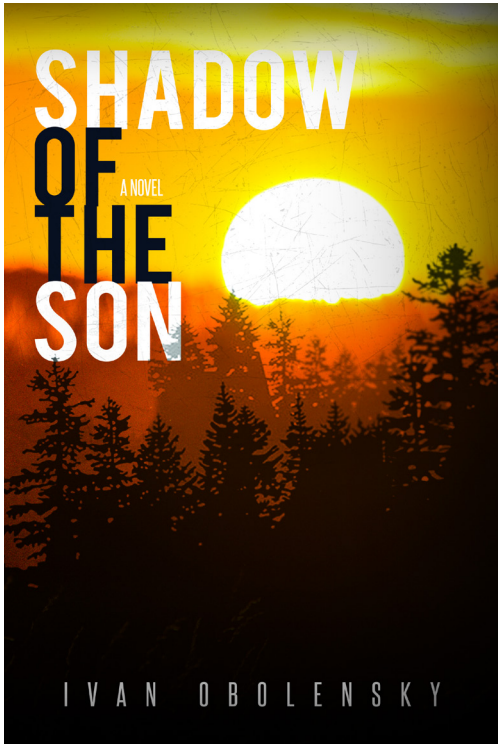


SHADOW OF THE SON
